How did you come up with the idea for *The Not-So Secret Society*?

Matthew: I had the idea for a story about kids who have

incredible adventures in NYC. There would be one kid from each of the five boroughs. It germinated for a long time.

Trevor: Matt and I were looking for our next great project and that story became *The Not-So Secret Society*. We dove right in and started sketching out the world of the NS3.

Arlene: I was able to add my own personal experiences of growing up in NYC.

Ellen: Together we worked incredibly hard to bring all the ideas to life, and it's become one of our favorite projects!

There's material in the back of the book and on TeamNS3.com for parents and educators to share with kids. Why is it important to you to include this?

Arlene: We are all parents and it's important to be able to bond with your children through reading. This guide helps tremendously. Having these activities built in (and not having to figure out your own) is a busy parent's dream.

Matthew: There are always so many great books on the market. Parents and educators are always looking for a little something extra. We wanted to give them great supplementary materials so they could enhance the reading experience for their kids and students.

Tell us a little bit about the NS3 members.

Arlene: The characters are inspired by our family. They are

some of the funniest and most interesting kids that I know, so it was easy to draw from that. Madison is a born leader; Aidan is always full of ideas; Emma is shy but powerful; Dylan is too smart for his own good; and Ava is our helper (even if she doesn't always have the best ideas).

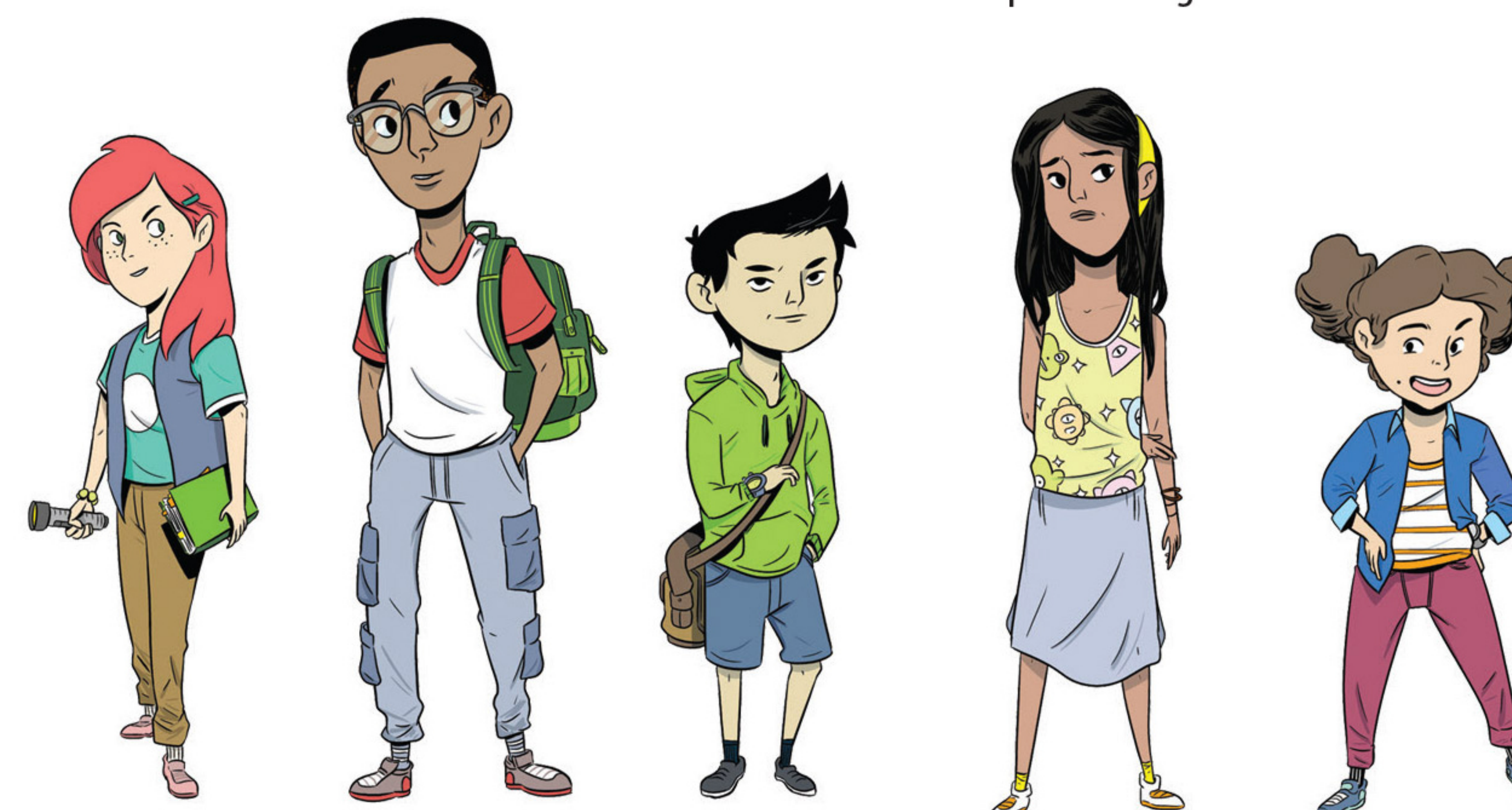
Matthew: It was important to all of us that the kids shared the "main character" spotlight. By the end of the book, you'll know all of the kids very well.

Trevor: They each have moments that let their unique personality shine.

Ellen: But their strength always comes from their collaboration and friendship.
